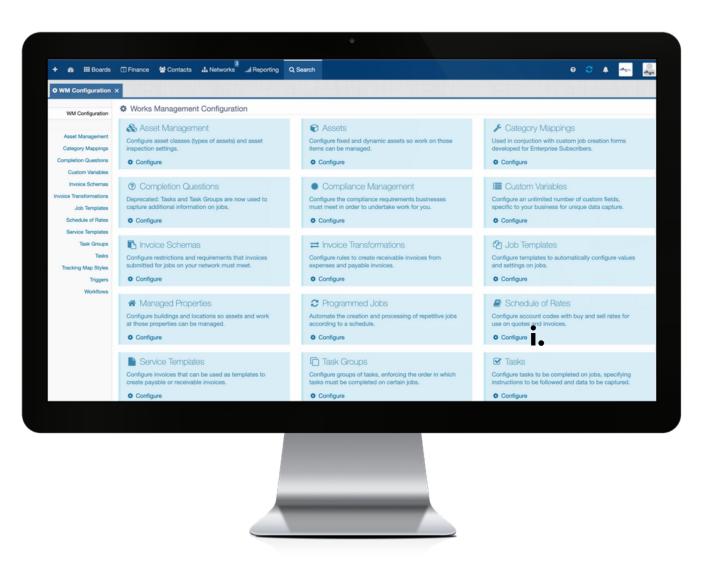
1. GET STARTED



Establish the settings for your Schedule of Rates feature via your organisation's Works Management Configuration (WM Configuration) section.

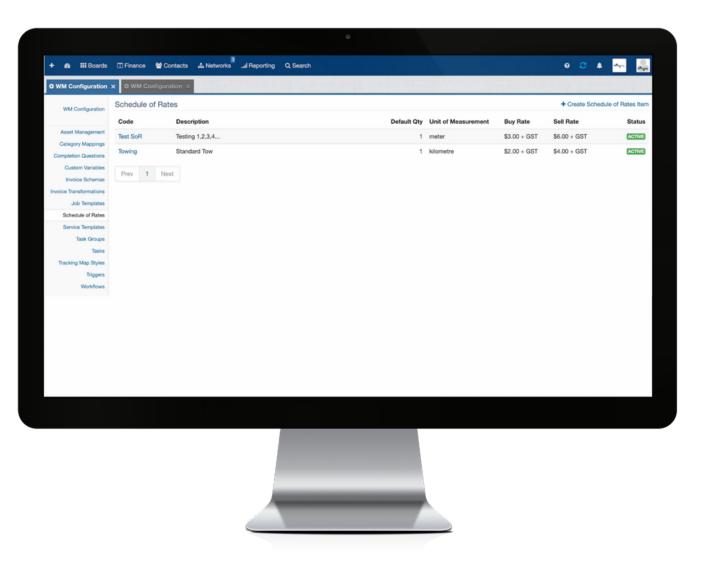
Your WM Configuration section can be found by clicking on the icon (i) for your Organisation's Profile and then selecting the Works Management Configuration from within the drop down menu (ii).

2. WM CONFIGURATION



i: To commence establishing the settings for your Schedule of Rates feature, click on Configure.

3. SETTINGS: MAIN VIEW



Configure settings to establish Buy and Sell rates for labour and material charges, which will provide consistency and easy use on quotes and invoices.

Legend: main view of Schedule of Rates settings page

Code: this is the Name of the Schedule of Rates Item.

Description: describes the labour or materials that the Schedule of Rates Item relates to.

Default Qty: represents the default quantity that will apply when the Schedule of Rate Item is applied on a quote and/or invoice.

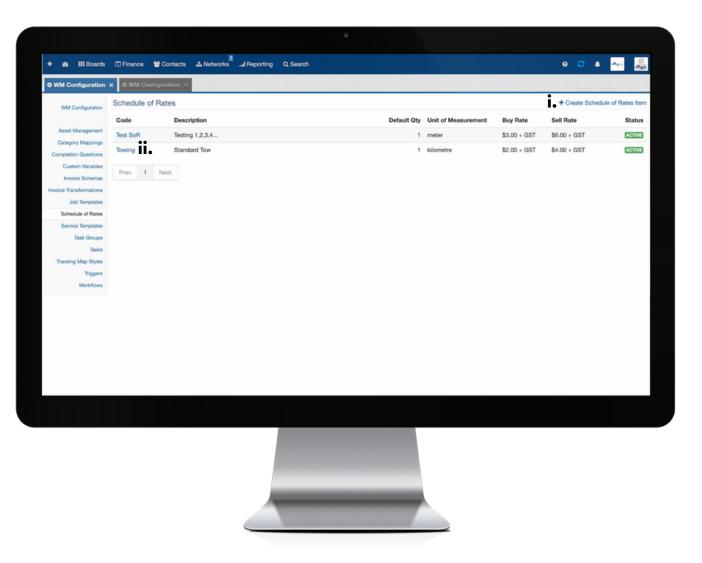
Unit of Measurement: represents the unit of measurement that will apply when the Schedule of Rate Item is applied on a quote and/or invoice.

Buy Rate: represents the Buy Rate that will apply when the Schedule of Rate Item is applied on a quote and/or invoice.

Sell Rate: represents the Sell Rate that will apply when the Schedule of Rate Item is applied on a quote and/or invoice.

Status: If Active, this indicates that the Schedule of Rate Item is in use on quotes and/or invoices. If Inactive, this indicates that the Schedule of Rate Item is not in use on quotes and/or invoices.

4. CREATE A NEW/EDIT A SCHEDULE OF RATES ITEM



i: click + Create Schedule of Rates Item to open the Create a Schedule of Rates Item dialog box; or

ii: to edit the details of an existing Schedule of Rates Item, click the Code name to open the Create a Schedule of Rates Item dialog box.

vi: complete this filed to set the Sell Rate.

vii: check this box if GST is to be applied to this Item.

viii: check this box to enable Providers to use this Item to submit quotes/invoices to you (the Buy Rate will be used; Providers will never see the Sell Rate).

ix: check this box to enable or disable the use of this Item on quotes and/or invoices.

x: click Create to save all applied settings.
